

Woodland Home in Maine

Imagine a vacation spot that is both completely restful and amazingly exciting. This woodland cabin in Wells, Maine sits on a burbling brook that feeds a small pond where blue herons hunt the bullfrogs that croak into the night. With room to comfortably sleep six, the cabin is also a five minute drive from the trendy summer downtown of Ogunquit, and one of Maine's longest and most beautiful sandy beaches. The cabin is rustic, but with finished touches like a lovely master bedroom and bathroom suite, a full-functional kitchen and a barn where another two can sleep more rustically, and where nighttime ping pong matches can stretch into the early hours. Just a short drive from the

exciting port cities of Portland and Portsmouth, with dozens of acclaimed restaurants, some of Maine's finest craft beers and hours of shopping opportunities. The cabin is not winterized, and is a summer-only rental used by one family.
