

## Middletown Police Department Ride-a-Long Package

The Middletown Police Department is the sworn law enforcement agency serving the City of Middletown, CT. The 114 officers cover 42 square miles and serve about 47,000 citizens. The department's personnel are comprised of patrol officers, detectives, and a host of highly trained, specialized units. With the approval of Chief William McKenna, the following officers will be available to offer up to eight hours (each) of a patrol shift to the winning bidder. Officers work varying shifts and each have different levels of experience and expertise. Officers include: Sergeant Fred Dirga; Sergeant Douglas Clark; Sergeant Brian Hubbs; Officer Ryan Jeffries; Officer Michael D'Aresta\* (Marine Unit); Officer Kristen Tyrsek; Officer Daniel Spedding; Animal Control Officer Gail Petras

**Item includes:** Your choice of one or more shifts. You can ride along with each of these officers on any given shift or just choose one. Only one person can ride-a-long on each shift and must be 18 years or older. You can give one of these 8-hour shifts to a friend or loved one. You have one year to complete these ride-a-longs.

Notes: \*The regular shifts that officers are assigned to can be chosen or appointments can be made. They are all flexible. \*Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend 2019 for the boat ride. \*A waiver must be signed and approved by the Patrol Division Commander indicating the hours of participation, the officer assigned, and the district being patrolled.
