# 2024: CHAMPIONING HUMAN RIGHTS & ADVOCACY

Gilead Community Services was founded in 1968 amidst a changing world. With a clear vision for an equitable future, Gilead's services and practices have evolved to continually reflect the changing needs of the world around us. However, Gilead has remained steadfast in its commitment to our founding principles and advocating for the rights of all people.

In 2024, Gilead achieved several milestones and wins that will impact the day-to-day lives of the individuals we serve while also investing in the future of high-quality mental health and substance use care for our community. After a lengthy legal process spanning multiple years, the fair housing case involving a group home we were forced to close in Cromwell has reached an end. Not only did we receive a \$2 million settlement but this win set a precedent for fair housing and disability rights nationwide. Together, staff and board members shared their perspective on how to use this money through a series of focus groups.

## INVESTING IN OUR FUTURE

A significant portion of this \$2 million settlement will help ensure a sustainable future for Gilead, our programs, and staff. After hitting our \$1 million endowment goal in January 2024, Gilead allocated \$1.5 million of the award to the endowment—ensuring the long-term strength of our programming and mission. An additional \$100,000 was temporarily placed in the endowment and earmarked for new program development. Finally, \$50,000 was put into an emergency fund to support staff facing personal crises or emergencies. These investments are promises for a future that supports staff and clients' needs no matter what.

## IMPACTING DAY-TO-DAY LIVES

A portion of the award will also directly impact staff and clients in short-term, immediate ways. Gilead owes its success to the dedication and hard work of its staff; therefore, \$200,000 went to providing one-time appreciation payments. Another \$50,000 was added to the Opening Doors Fund, a fund that

makes basic needs available to clients as requested. This boost to an important fund will directly change lives, from helping provide a month of sober living to ensuring that a client can spend the holidays with family without worrying about the cost of travel.

Then, of course, there are the milestones and successes that money can't buy. We are part of a larger community—one that extends beyond our programs and into the lives of those around us. In 2024 Gilead participated in community events like wellness fairs, the Middletown Juneteenth parade, and Middletown Pride. We are proud to be an agency that continues to stand by, advocate for, and champion the needs of everyone in our community. Truly the greatest investment is the one Gilead continues to make in building a strong, equitable, safe, and inclusive community.
